What can fit in a container? Many bags of clothes, boxes and boxes of books, lots of bikes, many, many crutches, and one powerful generator – singing the twelve days of Christmas yet? The Liberians will be in a few months when they crack open a very packed container.

Over 30 volunteers marked their St. Patrick's Day by serving. Volunteers unloaded trucks of supplies from all over the state. Partnering with **The Gathering Place**, who collects and redistributes educational, medical, and business supplies, we filled a 40 ft container, our largest yet. Not an inch was left unfilled.

In mid-May, the cargo ship is expected to dock in Liberia. The students of All God's Children will receive boxes of new black shoes and school supplies from our sister school, Lighthouse Christian in Gig Harbor. The nurse will receive examination tables and medical supplies for both schools. And, Sinkor School will have power for the first time with enough to spare for half of the city.

What an impact a pair of shoes can make, or a bike, or a mattress . . . what do you have around your home? We collect needed supplies throughout the year.
