New Desks for Sinkor School

The first batch of desks have arrived in Liberia! Through generous grants from the Tacoma Rotary and Lighthouse Christian School in Gig Harbor, WA, we were able to buy new desks for All God's Children Schools in Liberia. The first batch of desks went to Sinkor School in Monrovia, Liberia.

Sinkor School was using a motley mixture of desks and chairs remaining from before the war. 15 Gate had built some desks out of bamboo rods for their outdoor classrooms. All of the desks were well worn and prone to splinters.



The next batches will replace all of the desks at both the Sinkor and 15 Gate Schools. Now all of our children will have safe and adequate seating in all of their classrooms.
